Beef cattle are cattle raised for meat production (as distinguished from dairy cattle, used for milk production). The meat of mature or almost mature cattle is mostly known as beef. In beef production there are three main stages: cow-calf operations, backgrounding, and feedlot operations. The production cycle of the animals start at cow-calf operations; this operation is designed specifically to breed cows for their offspring.

Beef cattle production systems are defined as all commercial cattle production systems where the purpose of the operation includes some or all of the breeding, rearing and finishing of cattle intended for beef consumption. Article 7.9.2.

ANIMAL WELFARE AND BEEF CATTLE PRODUCTION SYSTEMS

The livestock population at any given moment describes the production system through the stocks of animals being farmed. The duration of a production cycle indicates how long is needed so that animals are ready to slaughter for meat, whilst others are being reared, or to give birth and in the case of cows, some sheep and goats can be milked.

In the chart we see the global production of cattle (beef and buffalo) meat. Globally, cattle meat production has more than doubled since 1961 – increasing from 28 million tonnes per year to 68 million tonnes in 2014. The United States is the world ' s largest beef and buffalo meat producer, producing 11-12 million tonnes in 2014.

Beef production takes place nationwide, with many animals raised in the Midwest, Southwest, and the western plains. A quarter of the world's land is used for grazing, and extensive pasture provides 30 percent of total beef production and 23 percent for mutton (FAO, 1996e). In developing countries, extensive grazing systems have typically increased production by herd expansion rather than by substantial increases in productivity.

Beef is the third most widely consumed meat in the world, accounting for about 25% of meat production worldwide, after pork and poultry at 38% and 30% respectively. In absolute numbers, the United States, Brazil , and the People's Republic of China are the world's three largest consumers of beef; Uruguay, however, has the highest beef and veal consumption per capita, followed by Argentina and Brazil.
